June 1896 – doing good business with heated season

June 17, 1896 – shipped out 75 cases of bottled goods

Feb. 21, 1903 – Business purchased by C. B. Cannon of Cannon Bros. cigars and tobacco

Putting in new machinery run by electricity, expanding

Worked with Memmon for 8 years

July 27, 1903 – Frank Cannon came from Omaha to dissolve the Cannon Bros.

partnership. C. B. Cannon to be owner of the tobacco and bottling businesses

June 20, 1904 – Business purchased by J. E. Keenan
