Syrian; Jan 1904 elected treasurer & trustee of Syrian Orthodox church; Dec 1913 A barn was built on his property at 15th & 2nd; Sept 1915 adjusted open hours at grocery store for fair; Oct 1918 business closed for several days because of flu in the family; Aug 1920 purchased a home on 8th Ave; Feb 7, 1930 – Store at 1806 Central robbed, 3,500 cigarettes & small amount of candy taken. Passed up 6,500 cigarettes in large cartons on the floor. Gained access by getting on the roof and coming in an upstairs window. Believed to be boys. July 1940 Got permit to build an 18x40 foot store room at 19th & Central
