### Joseph D McCartney

**Homestead filing** – Josiah D. McCartney, NW1/4 20-10-18 & SE1/4 18-10-18

**1907 Atlas** – J D McCartney owned property in section 10 and 17

**Archives Card File** – J D McCartney & wife celebrated their 50<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary in 1917. They homesteaded near Elm Creek in 1882

### Findagrave.com

Josiah McCartney was 23, and living in Helena, Arkansas, when he enlisted as a Private in Co. G of the 4th Iowa Cavalry on Aug 1, 1862. He wasn't mustered into federal service until March 11, 1863. McCartney was mustered from the rolls of Company G on Aug 8, 1865, as "absent - sick since July 4, 1865, at Nashville." He was later discharged from the service at Davenport, Iowa, on Oct 1, 1865. He applied for his pension on July 30, 1890. His application is #886,370, and his certificate #629,098. After his death, his wife applied for her widow's pension on Feb 16, 1923. Her application is #1,200,925, and her certificate #933,269.
