## **Kearney Hub**

Oct 25, 1890 – Mrs. Gust Hultman has filed a petition for damages against Tony Cornelius and his bondsman. Mr. Hultman was killed by the cars last spring while under the influence of liquor.

Nov. 2, 1890 – Important cases

...The third case is one growing out of the saloon. Anna B. Scott, wife of Aaron Scott, sues M. H. Salsbury, William Winters, Tony Cornelius, Albert T. Henry, Sylvester Weibel, and John Donahue for the sum of \$5,000, which amount she says has been squandered or lost by reason of drunkenness resulting from the sale of liquor to her husband by the defendants.

May 4, 1892 – Local Odds and Ends

---Tony Cornelius has purchased the opera house saloon, and has sold the one he had on the south side to his brother Jake Cornelius.
