Buffalo County School District #11 at Buda was organized in 1872. In 1918 or 1919 the school building burned. Classes were held in a barn until the next building was built. District 11 merged with District 28 in 1959. The school house, which is located on the north side of Highway 30 about a mile east of Buda, was then converted into a residence and was used until recently. It still sits there by the highway in deserted, run-down condition.
