The original one-room school house built in 1884 when the district was organized was replaced three years later by an \$18,000 structure which housed both the grade and high school. A few years later an addition was put on the building. In 1915 (or 1911-12) a new high school building was erected. This one cost \$40,000.

Some Ravenna citizens were incensed that the new high school in 1911 was built so close to Grand Avenue (first called Appian Way). It was felt that the students would be distracted by the noise of the street cars which were projected to run up and down that street. Street cars were never installed. In 1943 (or 1945) the building burned. The new building which was built to replace it has served as the junior high school since the new high school was built on the west edge of the city in 1968.
