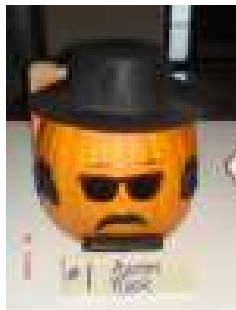

## Player Profiles

### Jimmy Jensen – F, 5’11, 194, 1-24-1988

Jimmy Jensen was born in Södertälje, Sweden. For the past three seasons he has been playing for the team Djurgården. Jimmy appears to be a set-up player, having scored twice as many assists as goals in the last two regular seasons. In his short career so far, starting with the season he turned 17, Jimmy has a record of 21 goals and 34 assists in regular season and tournament play.

Tom comes from St. Louis, MO. This fall, before coming to Kearney, he had started his third year with the Saginaw Spirits where he has been play-ing right wing. Tom played four games and had one assist this season at Saginaw. Last season he played 66 games and had 6 goals, 5 assists.

## What’s on the Website?

Have you ever looked at the Booster Club website? Really looked at it? Explored all the places you can go? There is a lot more information here than you can imagine. Let’s take a tour.

The website address is a long one -

[www.tricitystormchasers.com](http://www.tricitystormchasers.com).

The home page is the first page you see when

you go to our website address. In the center is a description of who we are and what we do. This description is in the process of being improved. Upcoming events are listed on the right. The Menu, a list of other places to go on the website, is on the left.

What will you find at each of these pages?

Go to page 3 and let’s go down the list.

**Membership** – Types of membership are listed here along with what you get as a member. Then there is a place to fill out your application for membership.

**Calendar** – The current season, now 2007-2008, is show by month with the home and away game schedule marked. Dates of Booster Club meetings in 2007 are also marked.

**Newsletters** – Here is a list of all the newsletters published by the Booster Club. They are posted on the website after the members have received their copies. Just click on the month you want in the year you want. Since these newsletters are .pdf files, there are some search features on the left side of your screen. If a month is missing, we did not have a newsletter that month. After reading a newsletter, just click on your Back button to return to the list of newsletters.

**Minutes** – You might think you are still on the Newsletter page but you are not. Check the top of the page. Now it says Minutes. These are the minutes of all the General Meetings of the Booster Club since it was organized. This page works the same as the Newsletter page. Click on the month in the year you want and it comes up on your screen. Because of some computer problems about a year ago when the server was moved, parts of some of the early minutes have been lost and some later minutes have not been reloaded yet.

**Photos** – Here is one of the main features of this website. Each year fans take pictures at games and special Booster Club functions. The photos are posted on the website in groups by event. Just click on the event and thumbnails of the pictures will come up. Click on a thumbnail to bring up the full picture. You have the Booster Club's permission to copy any of the photos. At the end of each season the photos are removed and we start over again with a new collection.

**Player Buttons** – This is another main feature of the website. Player buttons for every player who plays for the Storm in the current season are pictured here along with some stats about each. These buttons are sold at the Booster Club booth at every home game but may also be purchased from here on the website. Just enter the number of buttons wanted under the player pictures, then fill in the information requested at the bottom of the screen and follow the instructions there.

**Schedule** – This page contains the hidden treasure of our website. What you see initially is the schedule for the current season. Home game lines are purple; away games are black. On each line the date, opponent, and start time of each game is given. But that's not all. After each game the final score is entered. This causes the season's win-loss record and point total for the conference standings to update.

Now, go to the bottom of the screen. Want to know what the schedule was last season or any season since the team franchise came to Kearney? Click on the season and there it is, including all the play-off games. Final scores, win-loss records and point totals are also there.

Want to see what the Storm's record is against any other team they have ever played in the USHL? Go back to the bottom of the screen and click on the team. You will see the date played, the final score and a running win-loss total. Where else can you find this information?

**Contact Us** – Here is where you go if you want to send a message to the organization or any of its officers. First you see our mailing address. Maybe you would prefer to send an email message. In that section of the screen, select the board officer or person to whom you wish to send the message. Then put in your name, email address, and your message. Don't forget to click the little box at the bottom to send the message on its way.



**Board of Directors** – This is a very simple page on which each position on the Board of Directors is listed along with the name of the person currently holding that position.

**Links** – Here some links to other websites are listed. First there are links to other hockey-related sites, then we have links to all of the other teams in the league. Last there are links to a couple other USHL booster Clubs. More will be added as they become available.
